Kindergarten

- 2 ea Large Elmer's Glue Sticks
- 48 ea Pencils #2 Real Wood – plain NOT fancy
- 2 ea Hi Polymer Eraser -White
- 1 ea Large Plastic School Box with Lid
- 4 bx Kleenex (Large boxes)
- 1 ea Antibacterial Disinfecting Wipes - Large
- 1 ea Old, clean white sock (to be used as an eraser for dry-erase markers)
